Foreword

The present workbook in English morphology is meant to offer both theoretical and practice support to students who study the domain of English morphology.

The workbook places itself in the series of workbooks that supplement the courses in Contemporary English Language, alongside English Syntax Workbook (Șerban, Drăgușin and Hațăgan, 2004).

The material in the workbook addresses both students who study English morphology in the first academic year and those who prepare to take their graduation examination.

The body of information is organized in 5 sections. The first section offers a theoretical presentation of the main features that characterize the category of Number, the category of Determination (for the lexical category noun) and the category of Aspect, the category of Tense and Modality and Modal verbs (for the lexical category verb).

The rest of sections are more practical course in nature. Section II includes sets of exercises focused on nominal and verbal categories while Section III aims vocabulary practice. In Section IV we have included sets of mid-term test produced and administered to students over the years. Section V is centered on translation practice and offers literary texts to be translated either from Romanian into English or from English into Romanian.

We believe that the inclusion of a glossary of terms, an appendix with an almost complete list of irregular verbs as well as the last year's „teste grilă” in the graduation exam will help students progress in the study of English morphology.

We hope the present workbook is a useful instrument of study for all those who want to deepen and refine their knowledge in the English language.
